last night...

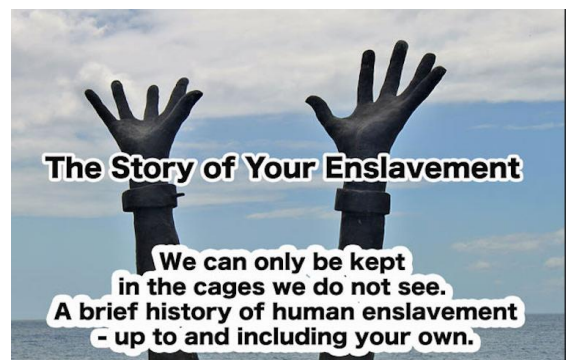
Running free in the field...
