Do not come into school if you have any of the following symptoms:

- A new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- High temperature – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back
- Loss or change to your sense of smell or taste – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal
- Everyone must wear a mask at all times when you enter the school site

At the end of the school day, only **ONE** adult per child can enter the site. All visitors over the age of 12 **MUST** wear a mask, unless they are exempt from doing so. Please remember to socially distance at all times.
