



Dear parent/carer

It has been a strange couple of years, from wrapping up warm so classroom doors can stay open and increase ventilation to coming to school in PE kit!

As a school, we think the children coming to school in PE kit has been really helpful, with fewer lost items of clothing and more time doing PE rather than getting changed!

This will therefore continue in September.

On their PE day, children need to come to school in plain blue shorts, a plain white T-shirt and trainers. If it is cold, they need a plain blue sweatshirt and plain blue joggers.

No pictures, slogans or motifs please.

We have included examples of the PE uniform above to give you an idea of cost so you are able to prepare for September when this will be enforced.

One child's PE kit should cost from:

Shorts 2 pack 3.00
T shirts 2 pack 2.00
Sweatshirt 2 pack 4.00
Joggers 1 pair 6.00
Total cost £15.00

If you do not label clothing clearly with your child's name then we will be unable to match it with the owner.
