

This week was the launch of Black History Month; our school values and vision champion equality and diversity, so this topic has been the core of our worship. Our school ambassadors Nelson Mandela, Martin Luther King, Rosa Parks and Gandhi inspire us to stand up



against prejudice and fight for justice. Our children talk with great passion about 'being the change they wish to see in the world' (quote by Gandhi). I am so proud of the young people they are and how they speak about what they can do to make our world a better place.

It was brilliant to see so many of you at the Bedrock workshop. Whilst I was preparing for this workshop, I did a lot of research to find out how it helps our children. A group of 84,000 pupils were part of a study. Children in primary education made 48% progress in their vocabulary because they did Bedrock at least three times per week. What an incredible way to improve reading. Well done to our champion Bedrock children!

The children in Key stage two, are learning all about what the 'Romans left behind' a fantastic topic that will be taking them on to think about how the Romans changed the design of buildings and life today.

Year I and Year 2 continue their topic about Kettering. A trip to Wicksteed would be a great way to celebrate this topic - Saturday is due to be bright and sunny. A way to get out and enjoy the autumn breeze!


