CREATIVE Have your paper and pens at the ready. The children can take home their worship creations. Something extra: Ask if any excellent responses / drawings could be added to the class floorbook / display.



LIVELY This could be anything from a dance to a drama. Ensure the children have enough space and have fun. Something extra: Take a picture of your response for your class floorbook and inspire the rest of us in school!
