

The children found volcanic moon rocks where they had to dust off the volcanic ash before they could decorate them. They then designed their own planets using oil pastels, they

discussed what their planet might be made of and who or what might live there! They also made planet biscuits using coloured icing and lots of different sprinkles. After that the children learnt about the first man on the moon, they learnt about gravity and oxygen and why the astronauts have to wear spacesuits, we then all tried astronaut food which was freeze dried, they tried strawberries, bananas, vanilla ice cream and chocolate ice cream.
