

cottage Pie Recipe Serves 6



Cottage Pie serves 6

Ingredients:

For the cottage pie filling

Spray oil

1 large onion - finely diced

2 carrots- finely diced

2 sticks of washed celery- finely diced

650g/1lb 7oz beef mince

1tsp dried thyme

1 tsp dried rosemary

salt and freshly ground black pepper

gravy granules

For the mash

900g/2lb King Edward potatoes, peeled and chopped

115g/4oz butter

60g grated cheese

125ml/41/sfl oz milk (optional)



Method:

- Spray the wok with oil in a large heavybased pan. Add the onion, carrot and celery and cook until softened. Tip it onto a plate.
- Return the pan to the heat and spray with oil. When it's hot, fry the mince, in batches if needed, for 4–5 minutes, or until browned all over. Stir in the cooked vegetables.
- Make the gravy using the granules. Add to the meat and vegetables. Bring to a simmer and cook, uncovered, for 20 mins. By this time the gravy should be thick and coating the meat and vegetables should be very soft.
- 4. Meanwhile, for the mash, put the potatoes in a pan of salted water and bring to the boil. Reduce the heat and simmer for 12– 15 minutes, or until they are tender. Drain and return the potatoes to the pan. Mash well, then add the butter and milk, beating to form a smooth mash. Season to taste.
- Spread the potato over the meat and vegetables and sprinkle with the cheese.
- 6. Put in the oven for 30 minutes.
