Hope the weekend is not too chilly.

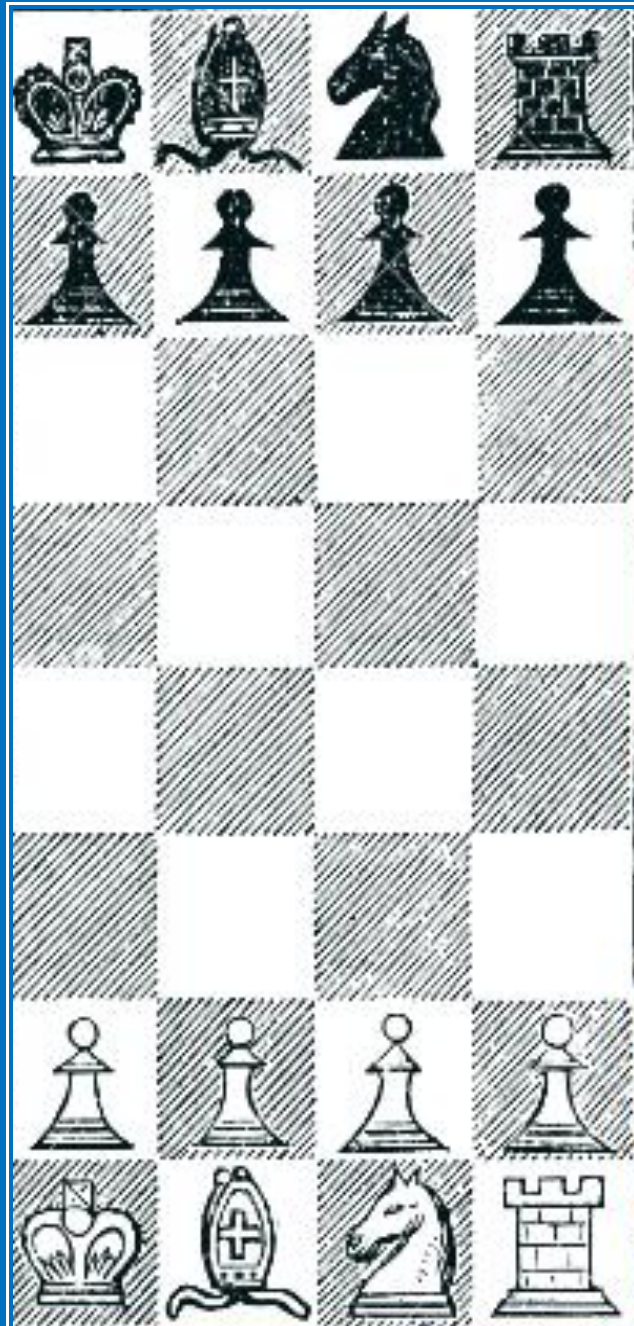
