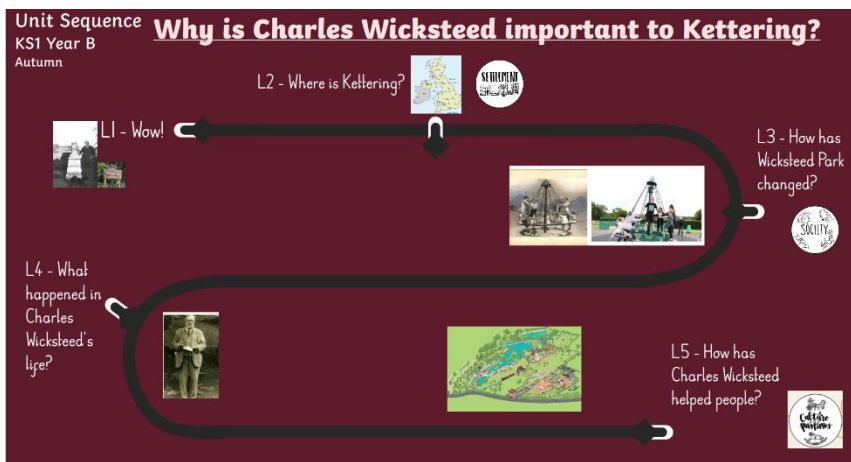


### Topic – History and Geography

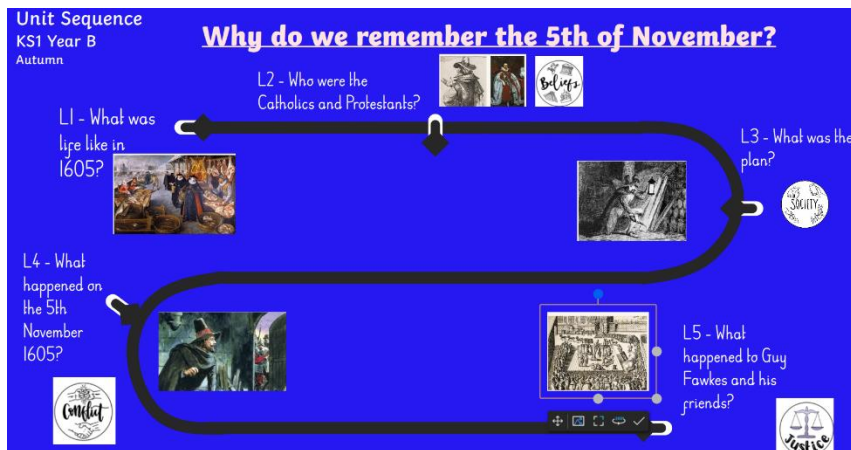
This term we are focusing on 2 exciting topics:

Living things and their habitats (Year 2)

This autumn term in science, our students will explore fascinating topics tailored to their age and curiosity:

- **Dolphins, Bees, and Deer Classes:** Our focus will be on "Living Things and Their Habitats." We will use our outdoor spaces to investigate various plants, animals, and their environments. Students will observe and discuss different habitats, understand how living things adapt to their surroundings, and learn about the importance of each habitat in sustaining life. This hands-on approach will help them connect with nature and develop a deeper appreciation for the environment.

## Religious Education

This year, we are thrilled to introduce a brand-new Religious Education (RE) scheme designed to help our KSI students gain a deeper understanding of different religions and their practices. Here's what each class will be exploring:

- **Dolphins, Bees, and Deer Classes:** We will start by exploring the question, "Who do Christians say made the world?" Students will learn about Christian beliefs regarding the creation of the world, focusing on stories from the Bible and the concept of God as the creator. Through engaging discussions, interactive activities, and creative projects, children will develop a respectful understanding of Christian views on the origins of the world.

Each class will participate in thoughtful and age-appropriate activities that encourage curiosity and respect for different religious perspectives. Our goal is to foster a sense of wonder and understanding as students learn about the diverse ways people view the world.

## Physical Education

This term KSI will be focusing on the topic attack, defend, shoot. They will learn to;

- Recognise rules and apply them
- Use and apply simple strategies for invasion games
- Prepare for and explain the reasons why we enjoy exercise
- Select and apply a smaller range of simple tactics
- Recognise good qualities in self and others
- Work with others to build basic attacking play

## PSHE

This term is centered around family and relationships. We will explore different types of families and work together to talk and think respectfully in our lessons. We will learn:

- To understand the value of families
- To consider what friends maybe thinking and feeling in different situations
- To talk to our trusted adults to solve any issues that we might need help with
- To know that remembering people who are important to us but no longer here can cause a mixture of emotions
- To explain what gender stereotypes are in relation to careers

### Music



This term in music KSI will be practising their listening skills to appreciate different pieces of music. They will discuss their likes and dislikes about the pieces of music they have listened to and discuss the moods the piece of music creates. We will also be practising ready for our Nativity performance.

### Computing



This term the children will develop their understanding of technology and how it can help them in their everyday lives. They will start to become familiar with the different components of a computer by developing their keyboard and mouse skills. They will consider how to use technology responsibly.



### Art and DT



This term in art we will be explore the artist Frida Kahlo and we will learn the following skills and knowledge;
